Projects

- *Monster Mower*, Individual Project July 20XX – Present
 - Modified a riding mower into a memorial project that sits over six ft tall with recycled Ford Ranger wheels and a car battery for higher current flow to operate lights and sounds
 - Converted a mechanical brake system into a hydraulic brake system to allow for more efficient braking due to the added weight
